Auditing: Collection, Evaluation and Communicating an Action Plan for Home Retrofit

Course Description:

This course is designed to provide instruction on how to collect, evaluate and communicate the information needed to develop an effective action plan for a home retrofit.

Length of Session:

This one day training class will include classroom training as well as an introduction to field applications.

Suggested Prerequisites:

Energy Basics and Pressure Diagnostics I

What you will learn by taking this course:

Participants will learn the basic concepts of building science, how a home uses energy and what information about the components of an audited structure are important for health, safety, durability, comfort and affordability. The class will include a review of basic retrofit material and techniques. The participant will review basic methods to determine area, volume and other calculations needed to complete a work order. There will be an introduction to the importance of employing advanced diagnostics techniques in the audit and retrofit process. Participants will also be introduced to computer modeling tools utilized in the Weatherization Assistance Program.
